## Equipment Operator

Status: Full Time Position  
Work Schedule: Monday – Thursday  
Hours: 7 am – 5:30 pm

Requirements include but are not limited to:

- Must have a High School Diploma or GED
- Must possess a valid Georgia license.
- Must be able to pass a Background Check and Drug screening
- Applicants with a valid CDL B are preferred.

Duties include (but not limited to):

1. Operates a farm tractor with attached implements to maintain rights-of-way.
2. Inspects equipment prior to use to ensure that it is in proper operating condition; checks brakes, mirrors, lights, air pressure, etc.
3. Cleans and makes minor adjustments and repairs to equipment.
4. Operates a variety of hand and power tools.
5. Repairs potholes.
6. Repairs and installs road signs.
7. Flags traffic at work sites.
8. Performs related duties.

### COMPLEXITY/SCOPE OF WORK

- The work consists of related equipment operation duties. Inclement weather, equipment breakdowns, and traffic contribute to the complexity of the work.
- The purpose of this position is to operate a variety of equipment in support of department operations. Successful performance helps ensure safe, attractive, and well-maintained roadways and related infrastructure.

### PHYSICAL DEMANDS/ WORK ENVIRONMENT

- The work is typically performed while intermittently sitting, standing, walking, stooping, bending, or crouching. The employee occasionally lifts light and heavy objects.

The work is typically performed outdoors. The employee is exposed to noise, dust, dirt, grease, machinery with moving parts, and inclement weather. The work requires the use of protective devices such as masks, goggles, and gloves
