*Tangible applies to Merchants Tools, Construction Equipment, and Airplanes.

- Airplanes billed locally since 1999 Tax Bills at State Rate at 1½¢ and local option if not used for Hire. Full rate if used for Hire.

Tangible rates for Merchants Inventory were changed by Legislature for 1990.

- The State rate is .05 per \$100.
- The County, City, and School rates are the same as the other Tangible rates.

Leasehold .015 State rate only.

Oil Assessments are taxed as Real Estate and Assessments are prepared & taxed from Frankfort since 1998.

Manufactures Inventory state rate changed by Legislature for 1990 to .05 per \$100.

Intangible property tax is no longer assessed as of January 1, 2006.
