in the building caused by this unexpected and unforeseen occurrence endangers the health and safety of the public and the
state employees working there. This emergency situation requires the immediate replacement of the 11 HVAC units as soon
as possible, without requiring the normal bidding procedures, which are hereby waived as part of this emergency declaration.
The Chairman is hereby authorized to take all necessary actions as soon as possible to negotiate a proposed contract with a
qualified contractor, for presentation and final approval by the Board, covering all aspects of the replacement project. Aye:
