Fall Conference 2019

The 2019 SCATT Fall Conference will be held November 13 - 15 in Myrtle Beach at Marina Inn at Grand Dunes.

Announcement from SC Department of Revenue:

The South Carolina Department of Revenue Appraisers Mandatory (7 Hours) Continuing Education Course for 2020 will be offered at the CASC Conference in Beaufort, South Carolina on October 24, 2019.

CASC decided to allow the Assessors the opportunity to register for class first and then allow associate members the opportunity to fill the remaining seats not to exceed 50 people. This course offering in Beaufort is limited to the Assessors and Associate members who are members of CASC and are in good standing in order to register, which means your dues are paid.

The registration form will be emailed to you later; please make sure you get it submitted by the deadline provided on the registration form.

The 2020 DOR Course will be taught by staff of the Department. This year's course title is <u>"Property Tax 101 for County Assessors and Appraisal Staff"</u>. This is a 7-hour CE credit course that will focus on the duties and responsibilities of the county assessor's office. Topics include terminology, identifying, classifying and appraising property; determining if property qualifies for the residency exemption and agricultural use value, assessable transfers of interest; reassessment; appeals, multi-lot discounts; and other general duties.

Once the additional dates, time and facilities are determined, notification and registrations will be provided to each assessor's office to ensure all required appraisal staff and any additional staff members you wish to attend may register for the course.
